Illustrate a Poem: "The Sunflower Queen"

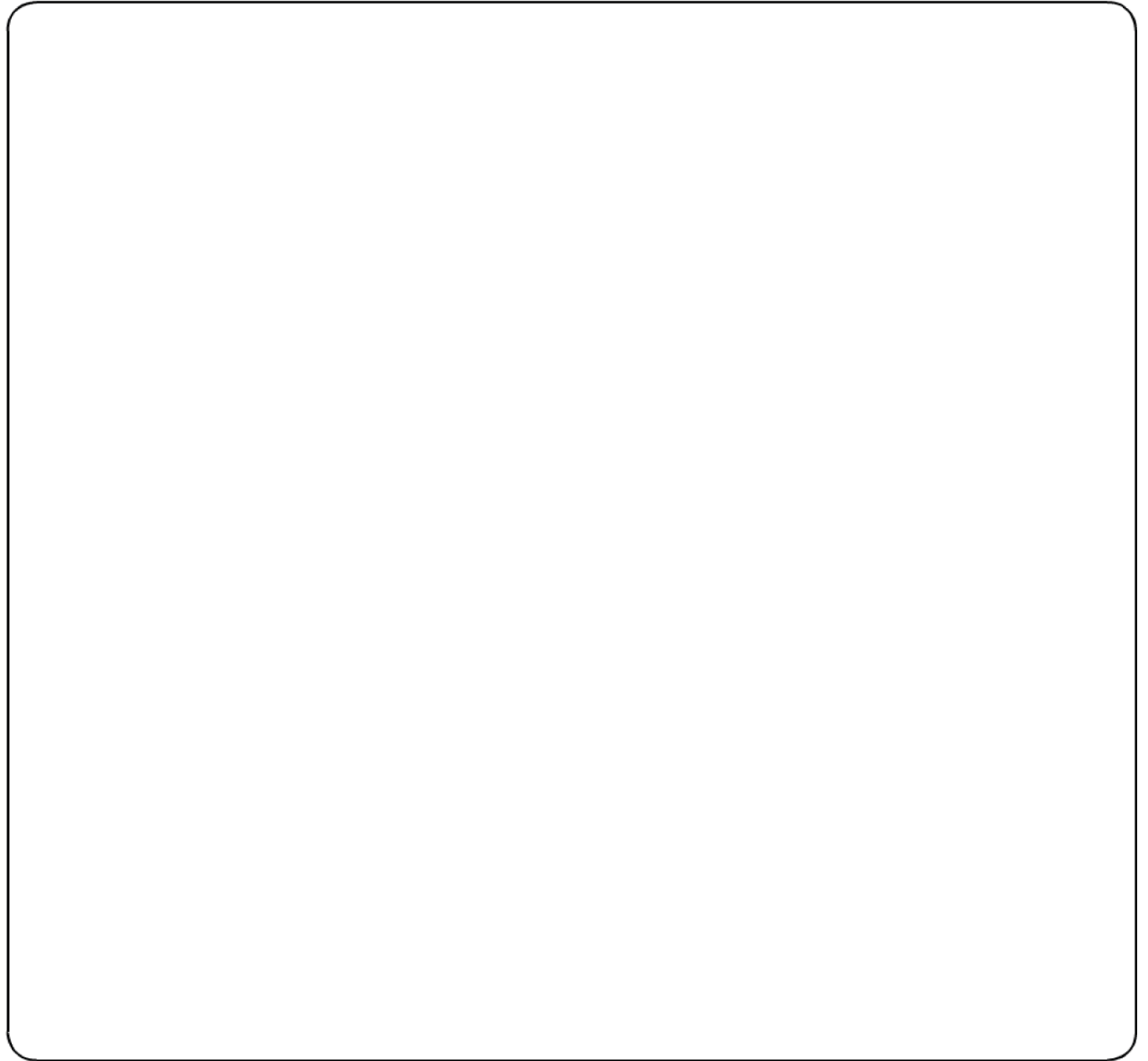
Read the sight word poem. Then draw and color a picture to go with it.

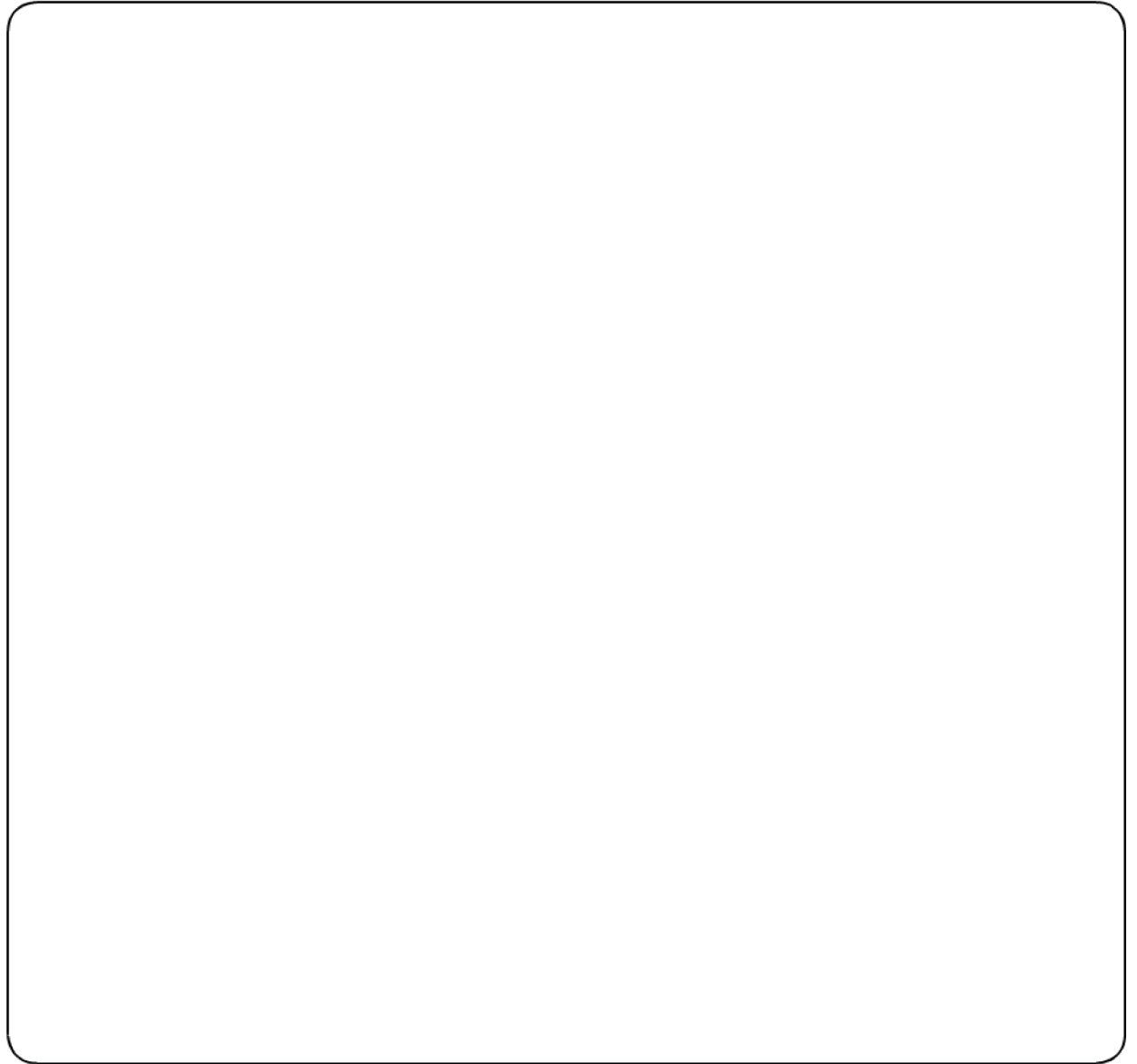
Illustrate a Poem: "Jay's Great Day with Grandma Kay"

Seagull Story

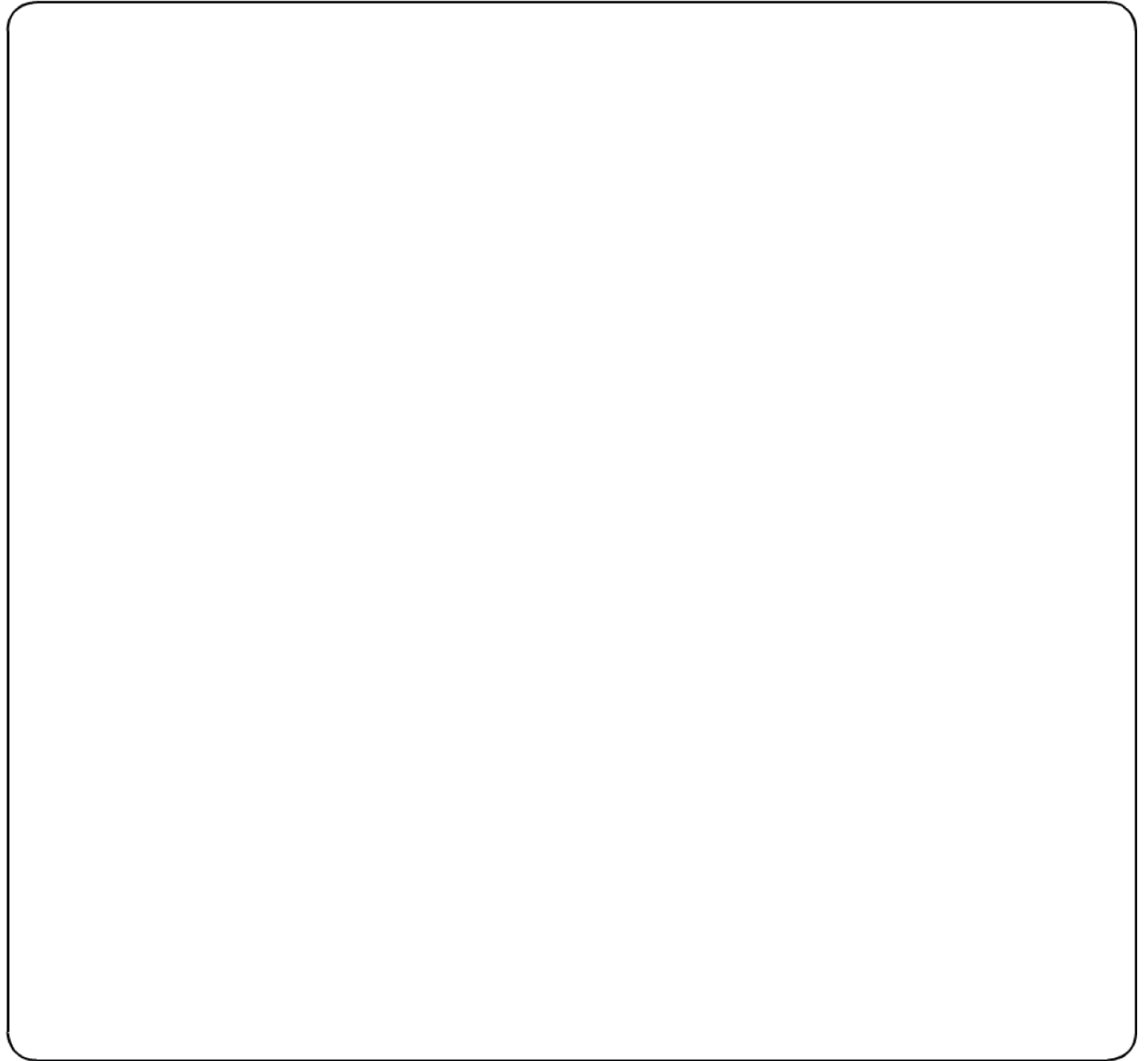
This **place** is where I used to play,

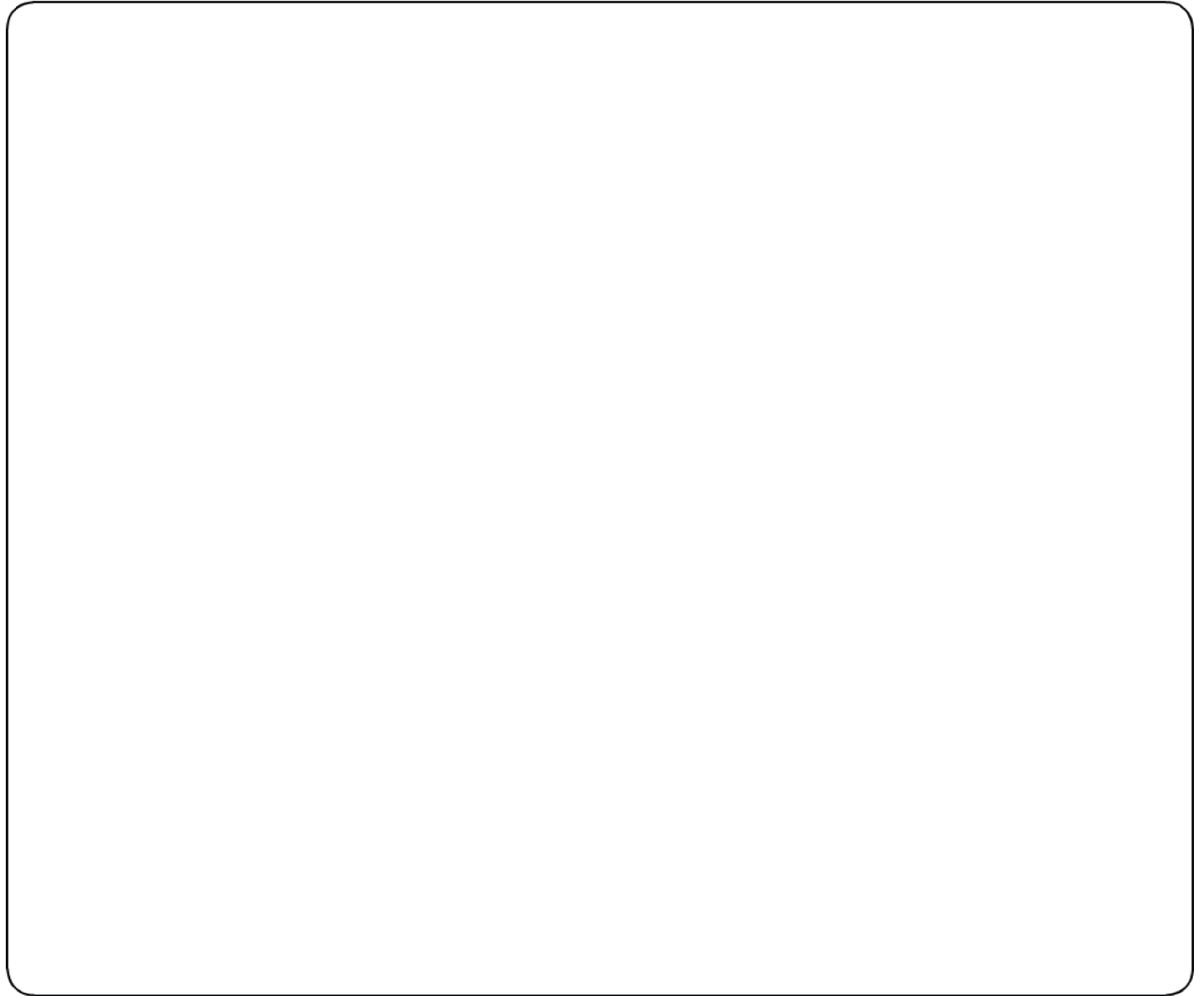
Illustrate a Poem: "Sky-High Hike"
