### 3 Letter Words

- box: a container with flat sides and a lid. “She packed her toys into a box.”
- fax: a method of sending documents electronically. “He sent the paperwork via fax.”
- fix: to repair something. “She needs to fix the broken chair.”
- fox: a wild animal with a bushy tail. “The fox sneaked through the woods.”
- mix: to combine two or more substances. “She likes to mix colors when she paints.”

### Simple Preschool Words

- six: the number after five. “She has six apples.”
- tax: a required payment to the government. “They paid their income tax.”
- wax: a sticky substance used to make candles or polish. “She used wax to shine the furniture.”
- exit: a way out of a place. “They looked for the exit sign.”
- next: coming immediately after. “She is next in line.”
- text: written or printed words. “He read the text on the screen.”

### Kindergarten Words

- taxi: a car that you pay to take you somewhere. “They took a taxi to the airport.”
- text: written or printed words. “He read the text on the screen.”
- extra: more than is usual or necessary. “She asked for extra help.”
- relax: to rest and become less tense. “She likes to relax after a long day.”
- x-ray: a type of radiation used for medical imaging. “The doctor took an x-ray of her arm.”

## Elementary Words

- complex: consisting of many different and connected parts. “The puzzle was complex and challenging.”
- exhibition: a public display of works of art or items of interest. “They visited the art exhibition.”
- explain: to make something clear or easy to understand. “She tried to explain the rules of the game.”
- flux: the action or process of flowing. “The river was in a constant state of flux.”
- galaxy: a large system of stars held together by gravity. “The Milky Way is a galaxy.”
- maximum: the greatest amount or degree possible. “She reached the maximum score.”

## Food Words

- flaxseed: the seed of the flax plant, used as food. “She adds flaxseed to her smoothies.”
- fox grape: a type of grape native to North America. “They found fox grapes growing in the wild.”
- extra virgin olive oil: high-quality olive oil. “She cooks with extra virgin olive oil.”
- tex-mex: a style of cooking combining Mexican and Texan cuisine. “They ordered Tex-Mex for dinner.”
- ximenia: a type of fruit also known as wild plum. “They tasted ximenia for the first time.”
- xylocarp: a fruit with a hard, woody pericarp. “Coconuts are an example of xylocarp.”

## Animal Words

- axolotl: a type of salamander. “The axolotl is known for its ability to regenerate limbs.”
- box turtle: a type of turtle with a domed shell. “They found a box turtle in the garden.”
- ox: a large domesticated bovine animal. “The farmer used an ox to plow the field.”
- xenops: a small bird found in the tropical forests of Central and South America. “The xenops searches for insects on tree trunks.”
- xerus: an African ground squirrel. “The xerus foraged for food in the savanna.”
- xiphosuran: a member of a group of arthropods that includes horseshoe crabs. “Xiphosurans have existed for millions of years.”

- axle: a rod or spindle passing through the center of a wheel. “The car’s axle was broken.”
- index: an alphabetical list of subjects with references. “He looked up the term in the index.”
- xylophone: a musical instrument with wooden bars. “She played a tune on the xylophone.”
- toolbox: a container for holding tools. “He grabbed his toolbox for the repair.”

## Places Words

- exhibition hall: a place where pictures, painting, sculptures, or other items of interest are displayed. “Let’s go to the exhibition hall to see that photography display.”
- Phoenix: capital of the state of Arizona. “We’re going to Phoenix for a family reunion.”
- xerox room: a room equipped with photocopying machines. “She made copies in the xerox room.”

## Environment Words

- axis: an imaginary line about which a body rotates. “The Earth spins on its axis.”
- exoplanet: a planet outside our solar system. “Scientists discovered an exoplanet orbiting a distant star.”
- xenia: the effect of foreign pollen on a plant’s endosperm. “The study of xenia is important in botany.”

## Emotion and Trait Words

- excited: very happy and eager. “She was excited about her birthday.”
- extraordinary: unusual or remarkable. “He has an extraordinary talent for music.”
- exhausted: very tired. “After the marathon, she was exhausted.”
- expert: someone who is knowledgeable or skilled in a particular area. “She is an expert in computer programming.”
- exuberant: full of energy and enthusiasm. “The children were exuberant on the last day of school.”

## Action Words

- expand: to become larger. “The company plans to expand its operations.”
- expect: to think that something will happen. “They expect good weather tomorrow.”
- explain: to make something clear or easy to understand. “She tried to explain the rules of the game.”
- explore: to travel through an area to learn about it. “They want to explore the new city.”
- extinguish: to put out a fire or light. “The firefighters worked to extinguish the blaze.”
- exude: to give off or release. “The plant began to exude a sticky sap.”

- examine: to inspect or study closely. “The doctor will examine the patient.”
- execute: to carry out a plan or action. “They need to execute the project carefully.”
- exercise: to engage in physical activity. “She likes to exercise every morning.”
- express: to convey a thought or feeling in words or actions. “He expressed his gratitude.”
- extend: to make something longer or larger. “They plan to extend the building.”
- extract: to remove or take out. “The machines extract orange juice from the oranges.”

### **Advanced Words Starting with X**

- xanthein: a yellow pigment found in flowers. “The xanthein gave the petals their bright color.”
- xanthic: relating to or containing yellow pigment. “The xanthic hues of the butterfly’s wings were beautiful.”
- xanthophyll: a yellow pigment found in plants. “Xanthophylls contribute to the colors of autumn leaves.”
- xeric: characterized by or adapted to a dry environment. “Cacti are xeric plants.”
- xeriscape: a landscaping method that conserves water. “They decided to xeriscape their yard to save water.”
- xerophyte: a plant adapted to grow in dry conditions. “The aloe vera is a well-known xerophyte.”
- xyloma: a tumor or growth in the wood of a tree. “The tree was examined for signs of xyloma.”
- xylorimba: a percussion instrument combining the xylophone and marimba. “The xylorimba has a unique sound.”
- xylograph: an engraving on wood. “The artist created a beautiful xylograph.”
- xystus: a covered portico or walkway in ancient Greek architecture. “The xystus provided shade and shelter.”

- xi: the 14th letter of the Greek alphabet. "Xi is a Greek letter."

- xeric: relating to a dry environment. "The plant is adapted to xeric conditions."
- xylem: the vascular tissue in plants that conducts water. "Water is transported through the xylem."
