#### **Harder Thanksgiving Words**

with Definitions

**Abundance**: Having a lot of something, more than you need.

**Aroma**: A pleasant smell that you notice, especially when food is cooking.

**Autumn**: The season between summer and winter when the leaves change color and fall from the trees. It's also called fall.

**Baste**: To pour or spread liquid, like melted butter or sauce, over food while it's cooking to keep it moist and add flavor.

Celebrate: To do something special for an important event, occasion, or holiday.

**Cornucopia**: A symbol of abundance, often represented as a horn filled with fruits and vegetables.

**Gathering**: A coming together of people for a specific purpose, often a social event or celebration.

**Harvest**: The process of gathering crops from the fields.

**Leftovers**: Food that is not eaten during a meal and is saved to be eaten later.

Recipe: A set of instructions that tells you how to make a particular dish or meal.

**Tradition**: A belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down through generations.

**Unity**: The state of being united or joined as a whole, especially in a family or community.

**Xenial**: Relating to hospitality or the friendly reception of guests.
