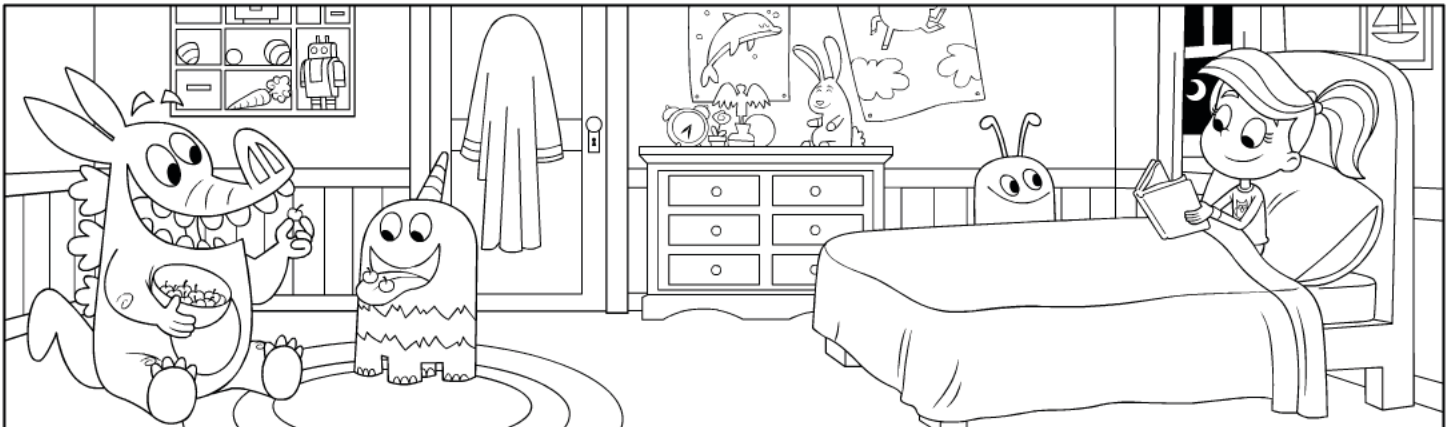
$$3 + 2 = 5$$
